2. What is the Gospel?				
A. What the word "" means				
Isaiah 61:1 The Spirit of the Lord GOD <i>is</i> upon me; because the LORD hath anointed me <u>to</u> <u>preach good tidings</u> unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to <i>them that are</i> bound;				
Luke 4:18 The Spirit of the Lord <i>is</i> upon me, because he hath anointed me <u>to preach the gospel</u> to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised,				

Note: The Gospel = Good Tidings (or Good News)

B. What the "Gospel" is

- 1st Corinthians 15:1 Moreover, brethren, <u>I declare unto you the gospel</u> which I preached unto you, which also ye have received, and wherein ye stand;
- 1st Corinthians 15:2 By which also ye are saved, if ye keep in memory what I preached unto you, unless ye have believed in vain.
- 1st Corinthians 15:3 For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received, how that (#1) Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures;

Acts 20:28 Take heed therefore unto yourselves, and to all the flock, over the which the Holy Ghost hath made you overseers, to feed the church of God, which <u>he hath purchased with his own blood.</u>

1st Corinthians 15:4 And that (#2) he was buried, and that (#3) he rose again the third day

Galatians 3:13 <u>Christ hath redeemed us</u> from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed *is* every one that hangeth on a tree:

Redeemed: To buy back; to purchase by payment of ransom

C. The "Gospel" is how our salvation was _

Revelation 5:9 And they sung a new song, saying, Thou art worthy to take the book, and to open the seals thereof: for thou wast slain, and <u>hast redeemed</u> us to God by thy blood out of every kindred, and tongue, and people, and nation;

3. How this conversation may go:

- A. How to explain the Gospel
 - #1. Read the passage:

according to the scriptures:

<u>Romans 5:8</u> But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while <u>we were yet sinners</u>, <u>Christ died for us.</u>

<u>John 3:16</u> For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

#2. Reveal the truth:

Explanation: Just because the gift is free doesn't mean someone did not pay for it. Since God wants to give you a gift, He's the giver and you're the receiver, so He paid for the gift. Jesus paid for the gift by His death, burial and resurrection.

<u>Note:</u> Take your time here, to thoroughly explain the Gospel: the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus Christ.

Explaining the Gospel even further (if needed):

- (1) The Bible says that Jesus died for our sins (Colossians 1:14)
- (2) That he was born of a virgin (Matthew 1:23-25)
- (3) That he was God in the flesh (Philippians 2:6-8)
- (4) That he did not deserve to die—because Jesus never sinned (2 Corinthians 5:20-21)
- (5) He died to pay for our sins (1 John 3:5)
- (6) Jesus went to Hell for three days and three nights (Acts 2:31)

#3. Review the concept:

Question: Do you believe that Jesus died, was buried, spent three days and three nights in hell and was resurrected to pay for your sins?
